

Plowing or pushing snow into the road is forbidden by Town of Mendon by laws, Chapter IX, Section 5.

“No person other than an employee in the service of the



Commonwealth or any political division thereof or an employee in the service of an independent contractor acting for the commonwealth or any such subdivision **shall pile, push or plow snow or ice into a State or Town Highway** so as to impede the flow of traffic on such way. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for first offense, fifty dollars (\$50.00) for subsequent offenses.”

In order to keep Mendon’s roads safe and passable for both the residents and highway personnel, we enforce this law strictly and will utilize whatever means necessary to prevent this problem.
