

## TOWN OF MENDON COMMUNITY CHOICE POWER SUPPLY PROGRAM STATUS REPORT THRU OCTOBER 2018

Prepared April 2019

This report has been prepared by Colonial Power Group with information/data being provided by the Competitive Supplier and National Grid. The purpose of the report is to provide information about the Town of Mendon's Community Choice Power Supply Program, which currently provides competitive power supply to approximately 1,450 customers in the Town. The data provided by the Competitive Supplier is not available until three months after the month it is used. For example, power is *Used* in January, *Invoiced* in February, *Paid* in March and *Reported* in April.
