The meeting was called to order at 7pm.

The committee discussed the Block Party. There will be a sub-committee meeting Tuesday at 6. Kevin spoke with Troop 44 and they have contacted the committee. Sally says most of the vendors are lined up. The committee discussed the issue with the Drive-In. They have advertised a separate event the night of the Block Party and tried to claim the fireworks as theirs on Facebook. Several people complained and they re-worded their post. Kevin also spoke with the Chief who said they will have to find their one public safety details as Mendon will all be at the Block Party. Kevin said the Town Crier will interview AJ for the Block Party.

The committee discussed the Farm to Table event. The liquor license has been approved by the Selectmen. There was a mistake on the time, Dan will ask the Selectmen to revise it. Larry reviewed the event and budget. They have booked the local country band Southbound Train. Larry sad the initial budget wasn't great but now they have gotten a lot of donations. There may even be a possibility of having the tent, tables, and chairs donated. Kevin signed the contract for the band (**Exhibit A**).

Sharon suggests we add the menu to the website. Larry explains there will be Beef (roasts and burgers), Pork, Chicken, local vegetables, and local ice cream with blueberries and strawberries for desert. Dan will update Facebook and the website. Larry says we will need volunteers for the event. Jeanne is working on ordering custom wrist bands for the Block Party beer garden and Farm to Table food.

The committee discussed the parade. Dan reviewed the groups we have signed up. Kevin says he has tried contacting every possible group of the Shriners he can find with no response yet. He will try again tomorrow. Sally has reached out to the National Guard and they are going to send us a band. Kevin has

reached out to Milford fire, they are having trouble finding a driver for the truck. Dan discussed the budget and confirmed groups. So far, we have confirmed the following paid groups:

Dick asked about the pipe and drum group. Dan has reached out to them for an estimate. The committee agree to not accept any more paid groups after these. The committee also discussed the reviewing stand plans. Kevin explained Wayne Wagner will still be the grand marshal. Sally is going to see if the family would like to be on the reviewing stand or in the parade.

The committee discussed the Fireworks. Dick met with the Fire Department. They will have to secure the lower field for the fireworks. They may need to set up temporary snow fencing to keep people out. They are meeting with the State Fire Marshal soon to get the final decision. Sharon asked about the other towns. So far Blackstone has RSVP'd. Kevin is working on the others. Kevin explained our money through the state was approved but it may be months before we receive it. It would end up reimbursing the Town funds.

Dick reviewed the final banquet. The tickets have been ordered and should be in soon. They will be the same price as the first banquet, \$37 for 1 or \$350 for a table of 10. They are hoping to have them for the block party to sell. The plan is Dick will take care of the Brothers and Kathleen will take care of the public. The band Fried Cactus has been booked. Kevin said he sent a letter to all the VIP's requesting a RSVP by today. Dick said the event will be a tribute to the public safety and veterans. It will be a formal banquet with costumes optional. There will be a short program but no major speeches.

The committee discussed the money. Tom says we have 3 sources, the Town, State, and 350th and we need to decide what we can spend. Dick asked if the Town money will cover all insurance or just the Block party. Dan says he believes the \$10,000 requested by the Chief is for all public safety needs. Kevin thinks we should spend the 350th money first and leave the town money for last. Tom says it was approved to be spent and we should spend it. Kevin says we told people at Town Meeting we would leave it if the state money came through.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15pm.

(a) No Deposit Required.




