Notice of Intent (NOI) Checklist

Applications are due at least two weeks prior to the next scheduled meeting date. The Conservation Commission meets the second and fourth Thursdays every month.

Please note your application must meet the requirements listed in <u>Mendon Wetlands Protection</u> Regulations prior to the filing date. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
