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DON'T IGNORE YOUR MEDICARE MAIL! It's that time of year again! If you have a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO, PPO), you should be receiving information from your plan by the end of September. It is important to understand and save this information because it explains the changes in your plan for 2015.

During the annual Medicare Open Enrollment (October 15 – December 7), you will have a chance to CHANGE your plan for next year. SHINE Counselors can help you understand your plan changes, as well as other options you may have. Make your SHINE appointment early or save the date of Tuesday, October 21st at 10:30am for a comprehensive SHINE overview offered by Counselor Larry Goldman here at the center.

DON'T WAIT UNTIL IT'S TOO LATE!

Trained SHINE volunteers including Larry Goldman, Chet Twarzdicki and Robin Fletcher offer free, confidential counseling on all aspects of Medicare and related health insuance programs.
