We also need to seal up the corner on the Olney Cook Shop, find a way to keep out the water and get a quote for pest control. It was also mentioned that there is no chimney cap which is allowing birds to get in. Lynne will call Ultimate Chimney to get a quote for a cap. In the meantime, Kathy has sealed up the Chimney to stop it happening. We need to contact AHO gutters to come back and finish the gutter installation.

3. Cemeteries

Members of the HC will be sitting down with Lisa Lepore (archivist for the Historical Society) as she has done a great deal of work on the Town Cemeteries. It was felt that a website or Facebook page dedicated solely to the cemeteries in Town would be a great idea. Once we have all the information, we can start mapping out the Cemeteries and looking towards restoration and repair.
