7:02 Call to Order

Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order.

7:03 Approve Minutes

J. Lowell made a motion to approve the minutes of October 2, 2012. Seconded by T. Willoughby. Motion passed unanimously.

7:05 Barn at 133 North Avenue

J. Lowell reported that the new owner of the barn is interested in some CPC funds to complete his restoration of the barn. The Commission has invited him to attend a meeting and present his plans.

7:27 Olne Cook Artisan Shop

The Commission discussed the ongoing project.

Action Item \Rightarrow J. Lowell will call the architect and authorize the lighting and paint. She will also schedule an onsite meeting with him.

7:45 Permanent Sign Next To Town Museum

Resident Shirley Smith is concerned that a "Firewood For Sale" sign posted in the yard of the house next to the museum is in violation of the town's Sign Bylaw. The Commission discussed this. Because the Sign Bylaw lists the Building Inspector as the enforcing agent, the Commission decided to take no action on this.

7:50 Historic Districts

J. Lowell discussed the difficulty of finding an organization willing to hold preservation restrictions (preservation restrictions are required for any property that uses CPC funds for restoration/improvement). She suggested that an alternative may be to implement historic districts.
