Board of Selectmen Meeting

The Commission members discussed items pertaining to the conditions of both the old Museum located at 3 Main Street and the Records Room located at 13 Main Street. The group would like to present findings on the conditions report prepared by Brad Green of Colonial Restorations to the Select Board in order to ensure the buildings will be looked after and monitored by the town. Lynne will request to be placed on the next agenda of the Select Board.

Historical Society to House New Scanner

The Historical Society would like to locate the scanner at the Museum. This will allow access for all individuals. The Commission agreed to allow storage of the scanner at the museum. The Society will make arrangements for training and transporting the scanner to the library or Town Hall when requested.

• Demolition Application 30 Miscoe Road – update

Lynne has sent a letter to Mr. Morais and will wait for a response from him regarding 30 Miscoe Road. In the interim the previous owner Phillip Dion has made inquiries about the property and is in full support of trying to convince the owner to rehabilitate the structure. He wished to purchase it himself but does not have the resources to do so.

Blight bylaw

Tom continues to work on a Blight Bylaw. He has found the Upton bylaw to be a good resource to begin the process. He expects to model a bylaw similar to theirs.
