Selectman Chairman Vernon A. Barrows read the proclamation of the Girl Scout Week to be held March 11 to March 17 honoring the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Girl Scouts. The Misses Nadine Bonda and Suzanne Nadeau of Girl Scout Troup #476 presented a pot of seeded marigolds to Vernon Barrows, chairman of the Board of Selectmen as part of the Golden Anniversary of girl scouting. In making the presentation Miss Nadeau said in part: "We hope you will keep this flower pot in the Town office where everyone can see it grow--and will know that the Girl Scouts on their 50th birthday are still growing, too, and we say thanks to everyone who has been a good scout to us."
