# **PLASTIC**



plastic bottles, plastic jugs, plastic tubs

## **CARDBOARD**



boxboard, cereal boxes, food boxes, flattened corrugated cardboard **2 feet x 2 feet maximum per piece** 

# **METAL**



Metal food and beverage containers

**GLASS** 



glass bottles, glass jars

All items need to be clean and empty

#### **DO NOT** RECYCLE

- Shredded Paper
- · Wood material and products
- K-Cups
- Packaging (contaminated w/food or grease)
- Plastic Grocery Bags
- Plastic/Wire Hangers
- Plastic Wrappers (candy wrappers, chip bags)
- Plastic Film/Plastic Tarps
- Office Equipment
- Foam packaging and Styrofoam
- Aerosol cans
- Glass dishes/Pyrex/Ceramics
- · Windows and light bulbs
- Mirrors
- Stringy Materials
- Garden Hoses/Ropes
- Metal Cables/Electrical Cords
- Hazardous Waste

#### **ALL FIBER**

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, phone books, office paper, facial tissue boxes, cardboard, chipboard, wrapping paper, paper bags, paper tubes, file folders, milk cartons, cereal boxes, and juice cartons.



PLASTIC CONTAINERS #1 - #7
DO NOT CRUSH AND KEEP LIDS ON

Soda bottles, water bottles, laundry detergent bottles, milk jugs, yogurt tubs, deli tubs, drink caps, plant pots.



**METAL CONTAINERS** 

Tuna cans, aluminum cans, clean aluminum foil, pie plates, metal lids.



**GLASS CONTAINERS** 

Loose glass bottles and jugs.
