

Town of Mendon Board of Health 20 Main St. Mendon Minutes for February 8, 2017

Chairman Andy Fiske called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

Present: Alan Greenberg - Vice Chairman, Tom Fichtner - BOH Member

Location - Board of Health Office - 20 Main Street, Mendon, MA 01756

<u>166 Providence Street</u> – Fred Lapham of Shea Engineering presented the project to the Board. The current owners will be selling the house and will need to redo the septic system. Fred explained that because of restrictions on the site, they will have to request two local upgrades to bring the system into compliance. The abutter was notified and did attend the meeting. Ann McGreal is the abutter located at 164 Providence Street. She voiced great concern with the leach field being less than 100 feet from her well. The Board asked Missy to see if our Board of Health Engineer (Tom Ryder) can attend the next meeting to help address some of Ms. McGreal's concerns.

The Board again discussed capping tobacco permits and agreed to set a cap of 9. They asked Missy to contact DJ Wilson to see what the next step will be. Also, the Board will have Missy reach out to Eliot Brown regarding the incorporation of violations pertaining to cigars, as it relates to our Tobacco Regulations.

The topic of the Food Establishment Survey was briefly discussed. Currently, there is no update to report. Alan & Tom still working on a solidifying a format.

The Board reviewed the Animal Inspector Max Carbone's email outlining dog bite protocol. The Board requested Missy to reach out to Max to see if he can attend the next meeting.

In a past meeting, the Board briefly discussed changing the Hauler Regulations. They currently require haulers to submit a copy of their Haulers Permit from the town they are dumping from. There was consideration to do away with the requirement but the Board eventually decided to keep the requirement in place for the time being.

Alan made a motion to approve the minutes from August 3, 2016. Tom seconds the motion. All members agree. Motion carried.
