Capital Planning Committee Meeting - November 26, 2019

Members present: Jay Byer, Henry Marshall, and Matthew O'Brien

Others present: Dan Byer

- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:20 pm by Jay Byer
- 2. Motion to approve minutes from November 17, 2019 at 7:21 pm by Henry Marshall seconded by Matthew O'Brien and approved unanimously
- 3. Review and discuss capital requests by the Water Commission:
 - Enterprise fund does not have enough money to pay for anything that were to break
 - Old infrastructure (age of water mains 1947)
 - Any expenditure in enterprise fund has to approved at town meeting
 - Will probably see bill from Hopedale go up
 - Water commission will update long range plan from 2017
 - Requests over \$25,000 include:
 - Possible water storage tank 500,000 gallons (\$250,000)
 - Secondary connection to water system (\$100,000 estimate)
 - Possibly developing own water supply (form a subcommittee to check feasibility)
 - Company did study in 2003 in Mendon for water resources that says no surface water is viable but gravel wells are viable down providence road
 - ≥\$30 million at most
 - Items discussed under \$25,000:
 - Meter replacement in 15 years
 - Hopedale said that master meters need to be replaced (\$5,000 \$10,000), Mendon has to pay per contract
 - Shutoff valves
 - o Inventorying valves and hydrants
 - Possible repairs
 - Well with pipes to senior center
 - o Possible well pump replacement in Senior Center and Taft library
 - o Possible manganese In water would require spending to correct issue
- 4. Review and discuss capital requests by the Parks Department:
 - Parks department says they will attempt to self-fund what they can
 - Capital requests over \$25,000:
 - Permanent facility for parks department/ maintenance
 - Right now working from shell of building next to fire station

- Would like program space as well
- Facility would ideally be in park 30x60 modular building (\$166,000) with plumbing probably (\$175,000 \$200,000)
- Possibility of renting
- > \$400,000 \$500,000 to finish "shell" next to Fire Station
- Suggestion of taking over Senior Center and moving Senior Center next to Fire Station after finishing the "shell"
- Small utility tractor with loader and bucket (\$22,000 by itself but for \$30,000 you can get an enclosed cab and snow blower attachment)
 - > might be able to pay from revolving account
 - Suggestion that parks could get this machine and be responsible for sidewalks
 - Might be able to share equipment (and funding) with highway department as this is similar to their request
- o Paving parking lot at park (currently \$3,000 for new gravel every 3-5 years)
 - Paving would probably be around \$100,000 or \$34k for asphalt millings
- Lights on memorial and veterans fields (\$200,000 each)
- Possibility of dog park (\$100,000)
- Drainage project for park lot (\$50,000)
- Other items discussed under \$25,000:
 - Repairs to lights around basketball and tennis courts (budget is \$10,000 so far spent \$3,700 from revolving account)
 - Drainage at beach (storm water problems)
 - Repairs to classrooms
 - Shed for camp (\$10,000)
 - Snack shack (\$5,000 for plumbing and sink)
 - Replace roof (\$6,000)
 - Landscape trailer (\$5,000)
 - Landscaping of beach (\$20,000 project)
 - Renovation of beach houses
 - Cameras at park (\$6,500)
 - > Supposed to be 7 cameras now but there are only 2 (would like it to be 30)
 - Shipping container (\$5,000)
 - Tetreault field irrigation (\$20,000)
 - Outdoor AED cases (\$1,200)
- 5. Other matters not anticipated
 - For next meeting:
 - o Policy for requesting capital needs still being looked at
