Did you know the Town of Mendon offers a 50% reduction in trash fees for senior home-


owners who meet the following criteria:

News From SHINE: May 2012 Need help with prescription drug costs? Prescription Advantage may be your answer!

Prescription Advantage is a state-run program which helps many seniors pay for their prescription drugs. There is <u>no charge</u> for joining Prescription Advantage, if you have an annual income at or less than \$33,510 for a single person and \$45,390 for a married couple. (*There is no asset limit!*)

Who can join? If you are a Massachusetts resident, eligible for Medicare, and are:

• 65 years or older with an annual income at or less than \$55,850 for a single person or \$75,650 for a married couple OR...

• under 65 years and disabled, with an annual income at or less than \$21,000 for a single person or \$28,444 for a married couple.

If you are **not** eligible for Medicare, you can also join and there is no income limit. **How can Prescription Advantage help**

you?If you have Medicare, Prescription

Advantage helps pay for your prescriptions when you reach the Medicare Part D coverage gap (donut hole).

• If you are unhappy with your current Part D or Medicare Advantage plan, Prescription Advantage allows you to switch your plan *now*, instead of waiting for Open Enrollment in October.

• If you are NOT currently enrolled but you need a Part D or Medicare Advantage plan *now*, joining Prescription Advantage allows you to enroll right away.

If you need help on any aspect of your health insurance, call the Mendon Senior Center at 508-478-6175 for a SHINE appointment on Thursday, May 17th from 9-11am. Or you may call Prescription Advantage today for an application form. You can reach Prescription Advantage at 1-800-AGE-INFO (1-800-243-4636), then press or say 2.

Property Inspections

The Mendon Board of Assessors wishes to announce the commencement of the fourth phase of a town wide reinspection program as mandated by Mass General Law. This program will be completed over a five year period during which time all properties will be visited and all building description information will be verified for accuracy.

The Assessors have retained the services of Paul S. Kapinos & Associates of South Hadley. A representative from this firm, Bruce Webster will be registered with the Mendon Police Dept. and display proper identification. We will commence the reinspection process on Monday, April 9, 2012An interior inspection of the dwelling will be requested and entrance will only be made if an adult is present. If entrance cannot be completed during the initial visit, a call back card will be left on the main entrance with instructions to contact the Assessor's office to schedule an appointment. If a response is not received, an estimate of the interior will be made.
