On behalf of the applicant, Hartford East Corp, we are submitting a Notice of Intent for the construction of two single family homes with septic systems, wells, driveways, utilities and associated site work that will occur within the 100 ft buffer of a bordering vegetated wetlands. A proposed common driveway crossing will alter 700 sf of BVW with 1,030 sf of replication proposed.





On September 23, 2020, the wetland resources were delineated on land located at the above referenced site in Mendon, MA (refer to enclosed locus maps). The wetland border was flagged using the criteria in the most recent edition of MA Wetland Protection Act (WPA) and Regulations 310 CMR 10.00 et al and the Mendon Wetland Protection Ordinance. Hydric soil indicators, vegetation changes, hydrological indicators, and topography were all considered for delineation purposes.

One Bordering Vegetated Wetland system was delineated in the field with series A0-37 and GC1a-1P and GC 2-45. This wetland system consists of a forested wetland dominant in red maple, buckthorn, winterberry, high bush blueberry, poison ivy and wetland ferns, a wet meadow (within the gas easement) dominant in joepye-weed, loosestrife, goldenrod, sedges, rushes and ferns, and the top of Bank of a pond (flagged A1-9) and two intermittent stream channels which connect the two different wetland cover-types. Department of Environmental Protection BVW field data forms were documented at wetland flag # GC-25 (see attached form).

According to the Mass GIS data layers for NHESP, this site is not located within Estimated and/or Priority Habitat of Rare Wildlife; however, a mapped potential vernal pool is located within the delineated pond near the roadway. The site is not located in an ACEC, a jurisdictional FEMA Flood Zone, or within 200-ft of a mapped river.

The Town of Mendon and the MA Wetlands Protection Act takes jurisdiction over BVW/Bank resources. In addition, these resource areas have a jurisdictional 100-foot Buffer Zone. Any work within the resource areas and/or 100-foot buffer zone requires a Request for Determination (RDA) or Notice of Intent (NOI) be filed with the Conservation Commission.
