maintain draft. Estimated annual finance cost is \$80K, and should be a recurring	
cost for future truck upgrades.	425.000
Battery-powered extraction tools	\$35,000
Current tools cannot cut through modern materials used on vehicles. Battery-	
powered tools are more powerful and necessary for faster extrications.	400.000
Automatic CPR Defibrillators	\$20,000
Need to upgrade existing defibrillators to automatic ones.	4
Cardiac Monitor	\$35,000
Current monitor is no longer manufactured, replacement/repair parts no longer	
available.	
Personal Protective Gear	\$35,000
NFPA standards require equipment to be replaced after 10 years. Needs to be a	
recurring operational appropriation to maintain equipment.	
Thermal Imaging Camera	\$8,000
Necessary for faster searches, able to see through walls, current equipment is 20	
years old, newer technology exists.	
Pumper Truck (Engine #1)	\$550,000
Current truck is a 2003, 16 years old. There needs to be a plan in place to replace	
this truck once Engine #4 is paid off.	
Replace 2001 Pickup Truck	\$35,000
Still functionable, but will need replacement in 5-10 years.	
Replace 2013 Chief Vehicle	\$45,000
Still functionable, but will need replacement in 10 years.	
Station Modifications	
Current space no longer adequate for department meetings, need to rearrange	
space.	
Parks Department	
Permanent facility for parks department/ maintenance	\$200,000
Currently working from either the police station shell or the bathroom garage at	
the town park. No heat or bathrooms, no storage space. Also need program	
space. Propose a modular building (30x60), or moving senior center to shell and	
using existing center. Potential cost for shell \$500K.	
Pave Parking Lot at Town Park	\$100,000
Current lot has multiple sink holes, spending \$3,000 to fill in every few years,	
could be filled with Asphalt millings for less, but longer life expectancy.	
Drainage for park lot	\$50,000
Would be worthwhile if paving	

Small Utility Tractor with loader and bucket	\$30,000

Current sidewalk machine is 23 years old, continuously breaks down, the Flail	
Mower is 30 years old and is unreliable.
