February 10, 2016

Policy Review—Dick Skinner and Sue Carlson have been unable to meet to discuss the travel policy. Dick is willing to continue the review with our blessing. Amy would like a contact from the COA board. Kevin volunteered.

New Business

Kevin introduced Janet Hubener, the new part time outreach worker at the outset of the meeting. We all introduced ourselves and welcomed her aboard. She will work Wed and Thurs and Beverly Mon and Tues.

350th Anniversary Merchandise—Kevin asked if we could have a posterboard with pictures of items for sale displayed at the senior center along with order forms. Or he could set a date to be here with actual merchandise. Amy suggested a table at the April Book Fair.

Volunteer Appreciation—date set for Wed. May 4, 2016. Cultural Council approved entertainment but only partially funded this year. Friends will cover the shortfall. Amy will get a few quotes from area caterers.

Building Repair—Kevin reiterated what was said at last month's meeting that the senior center is badly in need of new windows. He suggested asking the Friends to look at options to get donations or discounts.

New Town Email Addresses—postponed until after the meeting is adjourned so Amy can give us instructions.
