Amy reported that we went in on a mental health grant with five area towns and it was approved. Need to hire psychiatric nurse or masters degree social worker to guide area outreach workers in recognizing mental health issues during home visits.

Amy received quote from Cataldo Paving to resurface upper parking lot which is three times more than verbal quote three years ago. Since this has been on Capital Planning list for several years, Kevin asked Amy to contact Kim Newman as the CPC is presently defunct.
