

Town of Mendon Board of Health 18 Main St. Mendon Minutes for March 20, 2019

Andy Fiske, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

The Board reviewed the comments from Town Counsel (Cynthia Amara) regarding the contract with Simply Recycling. Ms. Amara will be attending the next meeting to go over it with the Board. Andy asked Missy to reach out to Steve from Simply Recycling to attend that meeting.

Tom and Missy met with Town Counsel Cynthia Amara to discuss the issues with Marchand Septic. She agreed, given the history of this company's business history in the Town of Mendon, that she did not feel it was unreasonable if the Board requested additional requirements. Some reasonable examples would be presenting a copy of the owners Commercial Driver's License, proof of ownership by the son if he is taking over from his father, copy of the registration and possibly inspection of the vehicles that will be used in Mendon.

Ms. Amara agreed to attend the Board's meeting on Wednesday, March 27, 2019 to review the contract with Simply Recycling and Marchand Septic.

Alan made a motion to approved the minutes from January 23, 2019, February 20, 2019 and March 7, 2019. Tom seconds the motion, with corrections on February and March. All members agreed. Motion carried.

Andy asked Missy to send Lenny up to 28 Bellingham Street. He had received a call from Mendon Police Department with regards to squatters living in a camper on the property. The owner did not give permission but her daughter did. Andy wants Lenny to check on the septic line. It was his understanding somehow a sewer line from the camper was connected to the house system.
