



**Town of Mendon

Minutes for
November 16, 2016**

Chairman Andy Fiske called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

Present: Alan Greenberg - Vice Chairman, Tom Fichtner - BOH Member

Location – Board of Health Office– 20 Main Street, Mendon, MA 01756

35 Milford Street – The Board met with David Andelman from the Mendon Twin Drive-In for an update on the pending installation of new septic system. Mr. Andelman informed the Board That there is still ongoing legal action involving the previous owners. He is hopeful these issues will be settled by March or April 2017. He told the Board that they have two contractors that have submitted quotes for the installation of the new septic system. They are looking to get a third one. Their plan is the have the new system installed with a start date of October 15, 2018 and the system completed December 15, 2018. The Board was agreeable to that time line but stated that they would like a formal written agreement, which Mr. Andelman was fine with. To note, the current system poses no environmental health risk & regular pumping is occurring as needed.

80 Uxbridge Road – The Board approved a conditional approval for the new well to be installed as long and as a BOH member or the Health Agent (Lenny Izzo) is present to verify the distance from the tight tank to the new well and the property line to the new well.

The Board discussed possibly contacting a Title V inspector like Chris Lanoue, John Gibson or Harry Stewart to help with looking at the school leach field.

Alan made a motion to approve the minutes from August 31, September 14 and October 6. Tom seconds the motion. All members agreed.

Next meeting will be November 30, 2016.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alan seconds the motion. All members agreed. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
