MEETING OF THE MENDON WATER BOARD THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2001

Meeting called to order by Chairman Mr. Robert Carlson at 6:59 P.M. Mr. Donald Consoletti and Mr. Gary Gaffney were present. Also Administrative Assistant Melissa Kakela-Bottoms was present.

Ms. Christine Burke and Mr. Aldo Tarca from the Hopedale Water Commissioners were present. Mr. Robert Bird was unable to attend. Mr. Tim Watson Hopedale Water superintendent and Mr. Henry Papuga from Milford Water Company were present.

The Mendon Water Commissioners asked the Hopedale Water Commissioners and Mr. Henry Papuga from Milford Water Company to talk about the Route 140 contact. The last time the three parties talked, Hopedale wanted to purchase water from Milford Water Company and sell the water the Mendon for a short term. Hopedale has the ability to supply water year round the their Hopedale customers. Hopedale has found a new source and is in the permitting process. But Hopedale would be unable to supply both Hopedale and Mendon. So Hopedale would buy from Milford Water Company at high demand periods of time. The only difference is Hopedale would be a reseller instead of a pass thru, and Mendon customers would pay the same rate that Hopedale water customer's pay.

Mr. Henry Papuga showed a copy of how much water the Town of Mendon purchased in the years of 1999 & 2000 at Milford Water Company rates and Hopedale water rates. There is an increase of \$20,00.00 by Hopedale water rates. The difference is that Milford Water uses a decreasing block and Hopedale uses an increasing block.

Mr. Tim Watson informed the Commissioners that Hopedale would like to be self-sufficient within 7 years. Hopedale can not do that with Mendon on the end to that pipe. Other options are a wheeler fee or get an easement from Hopedale for a water main and just buy directly from Milford Water Company. Mr. Henry Papuga and the Mendon Water Commissioners agreed that would be very costly for such a small area.

The Mendon Water Commissioners asked that Hopedale come up with a wheeling fee. The Mendon Water Commissioners and Hopedale Water Commissioners agreed to talk at their own meetings and meet again.

The Commissioners talked to Mr. Henry Papuga about a problem with a bill for 6 Cape Road. Mr. Papuga said he would look into the problem.

The commissioners reviewed mail and signed bills.

Mr. Gary Gaffney made a motion to adjourn the meeting Mr. Donald Consoletti second the motion. All three members agreed. Meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
