Ch. 40A, Sect. 10, a Public Hearing will be held on August 17, 2023 in Mendon Town Hall at 6:00pm for an Appeal of the Building Commissioner's Decision for Cannapreneur Partners LLC at 47 Milford St. The property owner is appealing the decision of the Building Commissioner for (1) denying issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, (2) revoking an issued sign permit, and (3) issuing an enforcement order on the freestanding sign on the property under Mendon Zoning Bylaw Section 6.03C(vi), which prohibits freestanding signs for marijuana establishments.

4. Special Permit & Variance - 35 Taft Ave

In accordance with M.G.L. Ch. 40A, Sect. 10, a Public Hearing will be held on August 17, 2023 in Mendon Town Hall at 6:00pm for a Special Permit and Variance at 35 Taft Avenue. The property owner, Gregory Buckingham, is planning to build a single

family residence on an existing non-conforming lot and is requesting a variance for one side yard setback to be reduced from 20 feet to 10 feet.
